
Dear Mr. Castrilli,

I acknowledge receipt of the Canadian Environmental Law Association's submission in response to the Green Paper on Environmental Assessment.

Your response will be reviewed thoroughly by the Ministry and it is possible that staff may wish to approach you for clarification of certain points.

In the context of Environmental Assessment, our reorganization programme recognizes that any assessment activity (be it preparation or review) carried out within the Ministry has a close connection with the existing approvals programmes. The new Environmental Approval Branch will draw together all ministry approvals functions. This will permit an individual or organization to seek and receive a single approval from the Ministry, rather than several from various branches.
