
Thank you very much for the copy of your submission to the Minister of the Environment regarding his Green Paper on Environmental Assessment.

I received a similar submission from the Kitchener-Waterloo Pollution Probe.

Your brief appears to hit at the heart of the matter, which is public involvement in the assessment of environmental impact and also the responsibility of establishing what projects require assessment. Too often I have found that, in matters before the Environmental Hearing Board, public opinion and public input appears to be discounted in favour of a small amount of technical data submitted by the applicant.
