Re: 1974 PCAO Annual Conference

As discussed by telephone with Mr. V. Morris on November 7, 1973, we would be grateful if you could supply a speaker for the Pollution Control Association of Ontario Conference on Wednesday, May 1, 1974. The theme of the first session is "Environmental Impact Assessment" and would include presentations by Ontario Hydro, the Ministry of the Environment, the Federal Government, as well as the Environmental Law Association. Each presentation would be limited to 30 minutes, followed by a question and answer period of 10 to 15 minutes.

Subject to your own comments, we would suggest that the presentation might include:

- the legal profession's participation and advice in the proposed legislation and their recommendations on the type of legislation and public participation which would be most meaningful;
- the effect of the proposed legislation on existing laws and procedures; Provincial-Federal and inter-Provincial relationships; the policy field structure; etc.
- the effect on a project in terms of cost, delay and disclosure of confidential information;
- the type of legal training most suitable for representing proponents of new works in the presentation of environmental impact assessments.


