Enclosed is a copy of our Second Draft of guidelines interpreting and implementing the Washington State Environmental Policy Act of 1971, as amended. We have completed public hearings on this Second Draft and anticipate development and distribution of final guidelines, which will be in the form of Washington Administrative Code Regulations, sometime this Fall.

The Council on Environmental Policy will cease to exist on June 30, 1976, unless the Revised Code of Washington 43.21C is hereafter amended by the State Legislature. On July 1, 1976, all functions, powers and duties of the Council, under present statute, will transfer to the Washington State Department of Ecology. A copy of RCW 43.21C is enclosed for your review.
