Re: Eastern Ontario Plan Stage Environmental Assessment

Thank you for your letter of April 22, 1982.

The Canadian Environmental Law Association certainly recognizes the immensity of the work your association has undertaken in participating as the only intervenor in the above-noted environmental assessment hearing.

Staff of our clinic are happy to lend the assistance of Virginia Adamson for work throughout the hearing, as we consider it a very important hearing. We have discussed this arrangement with the Legal Committee of our Board of Directors. It, in turn, is recommending to the Board, which meets on Monday, May 3, 1982, that it give its approval. Consequently, we have arranged that Virginia assist Mr. Shrybman in doing research in preparation for the hearing, and in attending at the hearing commencing Tuesday, May 4, 1982.

If, for some reason, the Board does not approve this arrangement, we will notify you or Mr. Shrybman immediately. Otherwise, you may take this letter as our authorization for Virginia's continued assistance. The arrangements relating to disbursements will remain as stated in your letter.
