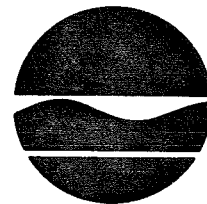

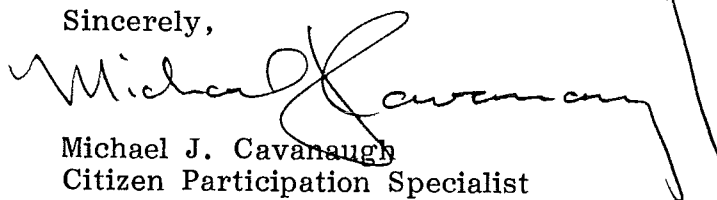
Dear Hyde Park Area Resident:

There will be a public meeting concerning the HYDE PARK LANDFILL at 7:00 p.m., Thursday, June 9, 1983 at Niagara University, DePaul Hall Amphitheater, Room 127. State and Federal Officials will be on hand to explain the progress of the study and remedial activities to date, outline future activities and explain in detail the recently completed aquifer survey program.

For the past several months, Occidental Chemical Corporation (OCC) has been conducting studies to determine how far chemicals from the Hyde Park Landfill have migrated into the groundwater of the surrounding area. The studies have consisted of drilling through the overburden (the soil over the bedrock), into the bedrock zone known as the "Lockport Dolomite", and down to the Rochester Shale layer. As the drilling progressed, groundwater samples were taken at 15 foot intervals. These samples were analyzed for selected chemicals that are suspected to have "leaked" from the Hyde Park Landfill. At the June 9th meeting, we will discuss how the aquifer survey was conducted and present some of the data collected by OCC. After the presentation, we will receive questions from the audience.

I look forward to seeing you on Thursday night, June 9th at 7:00 p.m.
