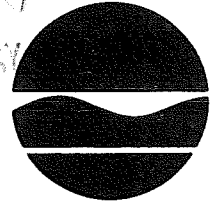

I am writing to invite you to the third in our series of "Hyde Park Update" meetings tentatively scheduled for 2:00 P.M., Thursday June 9th at the Department of Environmental Conservation Offices, 600 Delaware Avenue, Buffalo, New York. I will send you another letter detailing the agenda and confirming this date and location.

The purpose of this meeting is to help keep you informed about the status of activities at the Hyde Park Landfill, and to answer your questions and hear your concerns.
