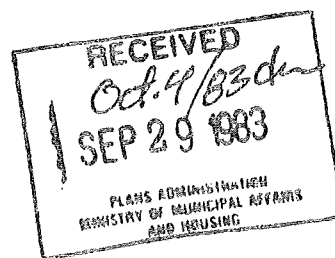

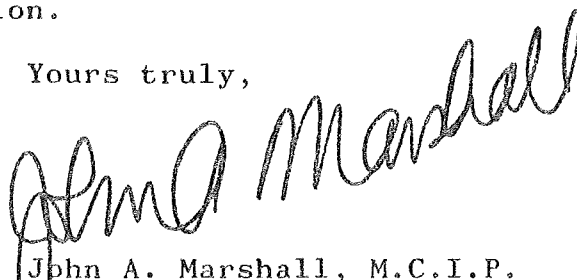

1. LAND IS SEVERED IN SMALL PARCELS OF 10 & 20 ACRES
2. SMALL PARCELS ARE NOT VIABLE AS FARMLAND ON THIS HEAVY HEAVY CLAY SOIL.
