To Whom It May Concern:

The enclosed "Application For Grant" is submitted on behalf of the West Burlington Citizens' Group for consideration at your Committee Meeting on February 1st., 1986. In accordance with instructions on the form we have also included our last audited Financial Statement. To date we have been an unfunded, non-profit, volunteer community group, therefore no budgets are required or set.

We require \$12,000. for the preliminary hearings scheduled in april in order to oppose the Halton Region's selection of Escarpment Site F in Aldershot for their future landfill requirements.

It is our belief that strong citizen involvement and representation at these hearings is vitally important to the successful outcome of this issue, and would serve to support and complement the Official City's representation in a very real way.

This grant is needed to meet all expenses, retainer fees and financial commitments necessary to ensure the continuance of the professional and legal services required to represent us throughout the preliminary hearings. The resources of the West Burlington Citizens' Group are all but depleted partially due to our involvement and expenses related to the past Expansion Hearings, and partially as a result of our activity to date on the new landfill site issue i.e. Public awareness campaign to increase attendance at both city and Regional Public Meetings, partial payment for further legal advice and representation, and retainer fees for consultants reports.

We have not been an organization geared to raise the large sums of money required for representation at the preliminary and final hearings, and while we have had some measure of success in raising money in the past the funds raised are now gone. We are however, starting to move in this area by putting together a fund raising appeal that will generate sufficient resources to support our efforts and meet our long term needs.
