**Re: Great Lakes United's 1989 Annual General Meeting**

Thank you for agreeing to speak at Great Lakes United's 1989 annual general meeting on nuclear contamination issues in the basin. The meeting is on the weekend of May 5, 6, and 7th, at Georgian College in Owen Sound, Ontario. Your panel is scheduled for 10:15 - 11:30, Saturday morning, May 6.
