RE: Environmental Assessment for Bruce A Refurbishment Project

Dear Ms. Miller,

Bruce Power has initiated a program to refurbish Units 1 and 2 at the Bruce A nuclear generating station. The program also calls for the eventual refurbishment of Unit 3 and the installation of new boilers in Unit 4 to extend the life of the entire station until 2035 and beyond.

To facilitate the necessary approvals, Bruce Power has completed an Environmental Assessment (EA) Study Report, which identifies the environmental effects of the project. The findings of this report will be presented at a series of Open Houses in the community beginning in late November. The exact dates and locations are listed in the enclosed newsletter.

Public and stakeholder consultation is an important component of the EA process. Please consider this letter to be an invitation to attend one or more Open Houses and meet with staff from Bruce Power and Golder Associates, a consulting company assisting with the EA.
