Hi Theresa and Keith,

I believe that you are both on the LIEN steering committee.

I just want to let you know how helpful LIEN's intervention at OEB hearings is in terms of obtaining OEB approval for more aggressive gas and electric utility conservation programmes.

In the past, the only intervenors who have strongly supported utility conservation programmes have been Pollution Probe and the Green Energy Coalition (Sierra, Greenpeace, Suzuki and Eneract).

Now that LIEN supports utility conservation programmes, the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition is also forced to support them. As a result we now have at least two ratepayer or consumer groups supporting conservation instead of just two environmental groups. Since the OEB believes that it has a consumer mandate this makes a huge difference in terms of getting OEB approval for more aggressive conservation programmes.
