Here, FYI, is CELA's original opinion letter, plus the update version. The one fed statute that I didn't mention in the opinion is the very short Nuclear Energy Act, which (unlike the NSCA) sets out the broad declaration that nuke energy development is in the "general advantage" of Canada (see section 18).
