The purpose of the meetings was to allow Justice O'Connor to learn first-hand about the impact on the community of the water contamination by E.Coli bacteria that is being blamed for illnesses and a number of deaths. Justice O'Connor extends his thanks and appreciation to those people who came forward to speak with him at the community meetings and in private sessions, and those who attended the public meetings. Altogether, there were more than 50 presentations by individuals, families and representatives of organizations to Justice O'Connor.
