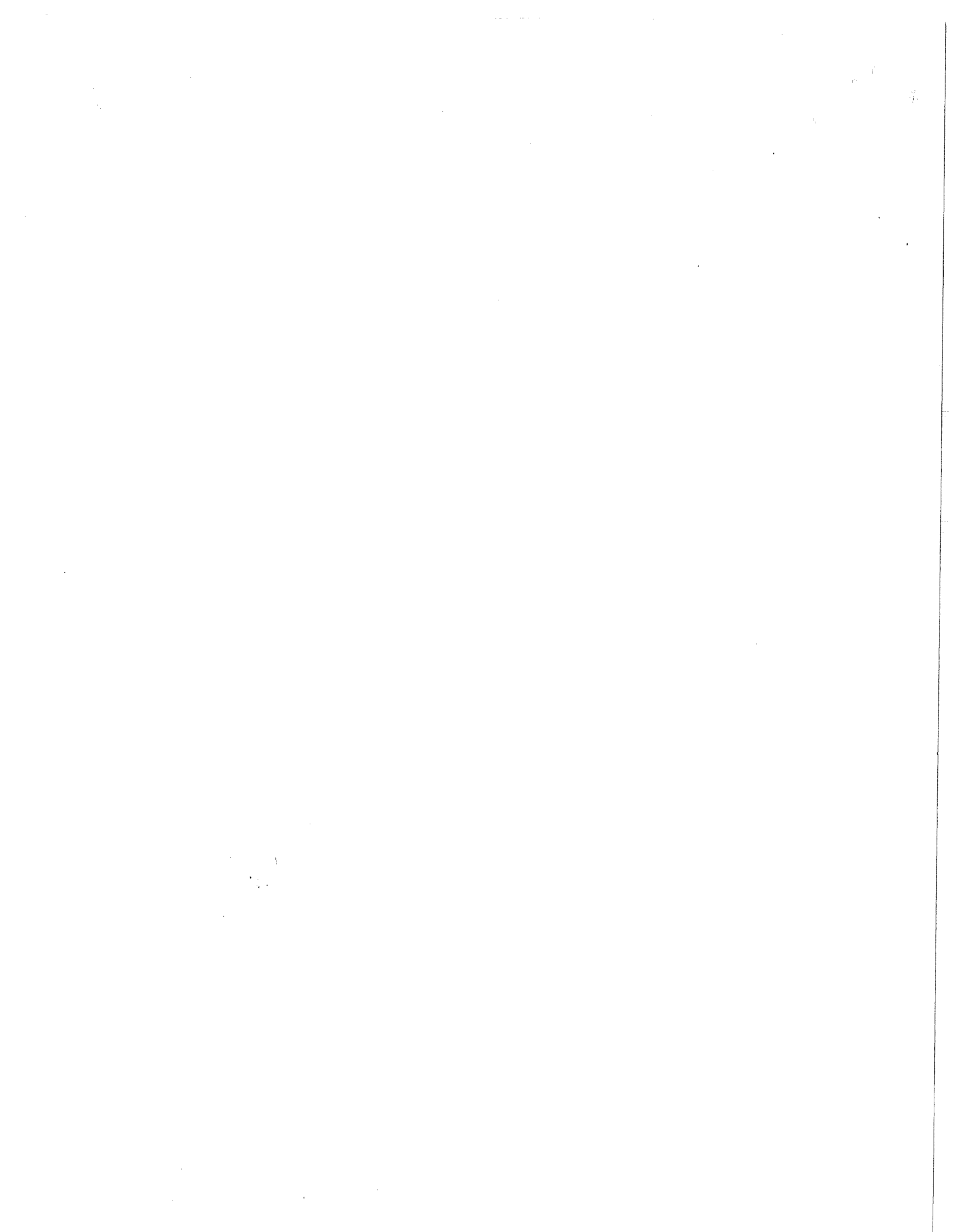
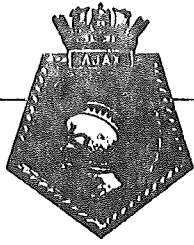

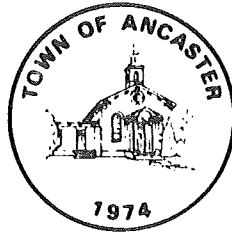

It is primarily for that reason that the consideration and the reply of the Aylmer Council was delayed.

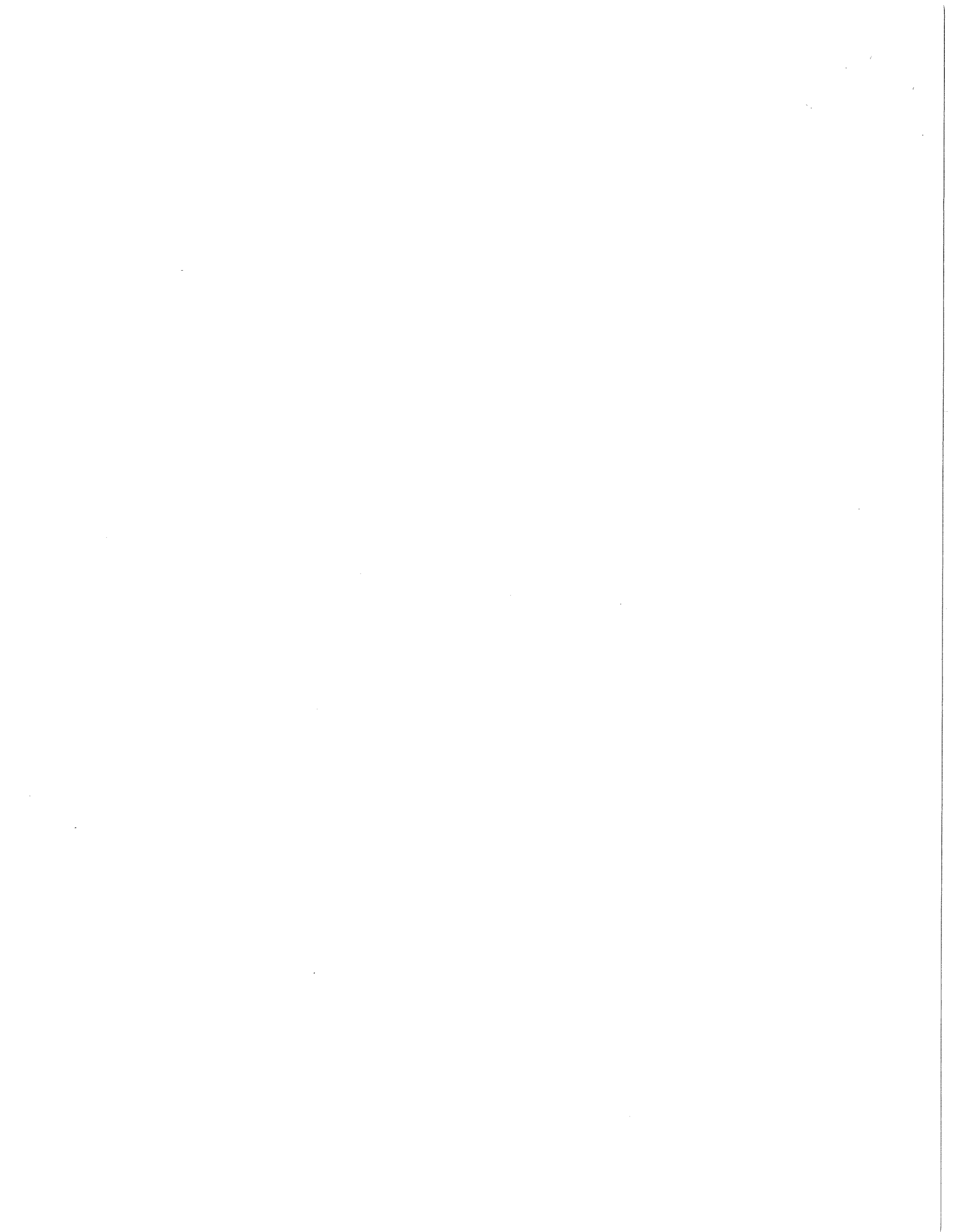

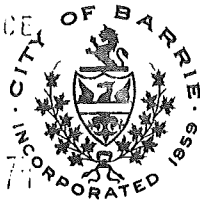

73-P-231 That we have studied the Green Paper on Environmental Assessment prepared by the Ontario Ministry of the Environment dated September, 1973. The paper outlines the rationale for an environmental assessment programme and the Ministry has requested the views of municipal councils and the public-at-large.

That we support the general intention of establishing an independent environmental assessment review system to ensure a co-ordinated consideration of potential environmental effects prior to approval of any undertaking of projects which may or may not involve an environmental impact.

Four alternative systems were proposed by the Ministry of the Environment for discussion purposes. After careful consideration, we recommend Alternative System "B" with the following revisions:

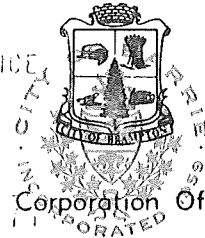
- (a) That the step involving the "decision made by Environmental Assessment Commission, No appeals" be amended by deleting the words "no appeals".
- (b) As a final step add "-refusals by Cabinet".
- (c) That Public Hearings be mandatory for major projects.

That the Minister of the Environment be advised of the above amendments and also that he be made aware of the following concerns of this Council;

- (a) The Green Paper does not appear to have given consideration to the involvement of local government at the initial stages of an assessment review.
- (b) The Green Paper does not define the size or scope of projects which would be considered to involve a detailed environmental assessment.
- (c) If any system of review involves a long approval or rejection system, projects which may have a major effect on a municipality could be unduly delayed.
- (d) The Green Paper does not appear to recognize that a proponent, when exposing an environmental impact project to the scrutiny of an assessment review, both public and governmental, may be violating the main private enterprise competitive weapon, namely secrecy.
- (e) In conclusion, we feel that if the Ministry of the Environment considers any system other than System "B", that a feasibility study system similar to that in use by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications should be thoroughly reviewed for adoption.
