Conditions of Approval

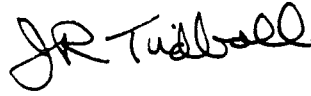
Please find enclosed a revised set of the conditions of approval that the Ministry will propose with respect to the Environmental Assessment Act and Environmental Protection Act approvals. Please review these conditions carefully as there have been numerous changes from the draft distributed on September 9, 1988.

Please note the inclusion of new condition 5.3 in the Site D EPA Conditions, which has been included as a result of my instructions to argue for the inclusion of a liner in the Site D design. Similarly, new condition 5.6 has been added to the Site F EPA Conditions to reflect the Ministry's concurrence with the need for a perimeter drain to intercept groundwater in the active zone of the Queenston shale, as proposed by Stan Feenstra.

With respect to condition 1 of both EA Act sets of conditions, we have accepted your argument that Halton has dubious legislative ability to be able to meet specific recycling targets. The recycling condition has therefore been rolled into a more general statement of principle.

Any comments on the attached conditions would be appreciated.
